The author's download of AutoCAD 2017 version was requested by a customer. AutoCAD was the first CAD program to support three-dimensional (3D) computer graphics, and its name was derived from "Auto," meaning "self-guided," and "CAD," referring to "computer-aided design." AutoCAD also includes features that provide basic drafting, 2D drafting, and other computer-aided drafting (CAD) functions. Unlike traditional drafting programs, AutoCAD is an integrated 3D design tool that's built on the Microsoft Windows and Mac platforms. It includes other tools and functions that provide a comprehensive, modern drafting and design solution. AutoCAD can be used to create 2D and 3D objects, create 2D and 3D drawings, work with layers and blocks, customize blocks, and perform various drawing operations. AutoCAD can also import and export graphics, as well as create non-editable 2D and 3D models. AutoCAD runs on a wide variety of operating systems including Windows, Mac OS, Linux, and Unix. It also supports a variety of computer languages, including C++, Java, and Fortran. The program is offered in several languages and editions to meet the needs of various types of users and industries. A broad range of products, including the AutoCAD LT line of products, can be bought separately or as part of the full AutoCAD program. AutoCAD is available in three levels of complexity: Basic, Standard, and Advanced, all of which include the same functions and features. The entire suite of AutoCAD products can be purchased at a discounted price when bundled together with additional Autodesk products. AutoCAD is the successor to AutoCAD drafting software, which was developed in the 1980s by AutoDesk. The original AutoCAD can be purchased in its own right. AutoCAD drafting has been around since the 1970s. It initially required a minicomputer running on a large mainframe system, with the user running on an external terminal connected to the computer. The three primary purposes of drafting are: • To create 2D drawings of objects • To create 3D drawings of objects • To combine the 2D and 3D drawings into a single image AutoCAD, released in 1982, offered a more user-friendly system. For the purpose of this tutorial, we have used the OBJ format, but the same process applies to any other format. To use the CELPUS SECTOR DICTIONARY, you need to associate it with the tool (see Figure 4.37). If you don't know where the CELPUS SECTOR DICTIONARY is, click the Start button, click Run, and type the name of the file, then click OK. When the command is open, right-click the CELPUS SECTOR DICTIONARY, and then select Properties. This opens the file's properties. The file is named either Hardware.tech.sav or the name of the file that is associated with it. For example, for the CELPUS SECTOR DICTIONARY we've used in this tutorial, we've named it.txt. Click the Display tab. Figure 4.38 shows the dialog box to open for editing the location. Figure 4.38 Display options Click OK to accept the location. The CELPUS SECTOR DICTIONARY is now associated with the Autocad Export tool.
